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Siskiyou Corporation's Policy on Responsible Minerals Sourcing

Applies to:

This policy applies to all Siskiyou Corporation direct suppliers who provide components which contain, or may reasonably be expected to contain Tantalum, Tin, Tungsten, Gold (3TG) and Cobalt materials.

Purpose:

Siskiyou Corporation seeks to avoid sourcing materials which contribute to human rights abuses or armed conflict. Our responsible sourcing of minerals, especially 3TG's and Cobalt leads us to implement a policy to use "conflict free" minerals where possible, source from transparent and responsible sources of supply, and perform due diligence management activities as addressed by the Responsible Business Alliance's "Responsible Materials Initiative" (RMI) and the OECD "Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas" to the best of our abilities.

Requirements:

Siskiyou Corporation will:

- Request and maintain current documentation from our suppliers showing their compliance with the RMI or similar programs/initiatives and guidance.
- Evaluate suppliers and their upstream efforts to source "conflict-free" materials as part of our supplier evaluation process.
- Maintain a transparent material sourcing policy (and practices) and provide certification to customers when requested.
- Suspend or sever relationships with vendors who consistently fail to follow responsible business practices including responsible sourcing of materials.
- Collaborate in good-faith with vendors and others in efforts to support responsible materials sourcing.
